### Dear Trackers,





## An ordinary Journey - images from the Arctic

Internationally renowned Scottish contemporary artist, Barbara Rae CBE, will be opening an exhibition of her latest work, inspired by her three Arctic voyages, in Edinburgh this August and Ice Tracks will be there!

As a member of the Royal Academy and the Royal Scottish Academy (just two of her many accolades) Barbara's vibrant paintings and prints, influenced by her travels to the Arctic, have a profound, mysterious quality: a primordial footprint. Her passion for the Northwest Passage (NWP) is inspired by her namesake, the Scottish explorer John Rae, who discovered part of the NWP, as well as reporting on the ill-fated Franklin Expedition.

Ice Tracks is also thrilled that Barbara is joining us (for her 4th consecutive year) on our <u>FoSPRI Greenland & Baffin Island</u> voyage in September 2018. So, if your night cap is a tot of whisky there might just be someone willing to keep you company.

When asked, who would you invite to sit next to you at a dinner party? Surely Sir Vivian Fuchs would top the list!

Sir Vivian's Commonwealth Trans-Antarctic Expedition in 1957 re-ignited an interest in both polar history and expeditions which had laid dormant since Shackleton's Quest expedition of 1921.

The first expedition to complete the crossing of Antarctica covering 2,158 miles with both dogs and motorised vehicles included three teams, one led by Sir Edmund Hilary.


