The Right Whales are heading home

Finally, after more than 300 years of decimation the Right Whales (named for the ease of being hunted) are returning to the waters of South Georgia. These glorious leviathans were particularly vulnerable as they would return to the same bays each year to give birth and whalers would simply wait for them, and hunt until none were left.

But like so many whale species, they are returning to sub-Antarctic waters,

under the watchful eyes of a team of marine scientists, led by Dr Jennifer Jackson from the British Antarctic Survey, that have set out for South Georgia. They will be surveying the whales in a 21 metre research vessel appropriately named 'Song of the Whale'.

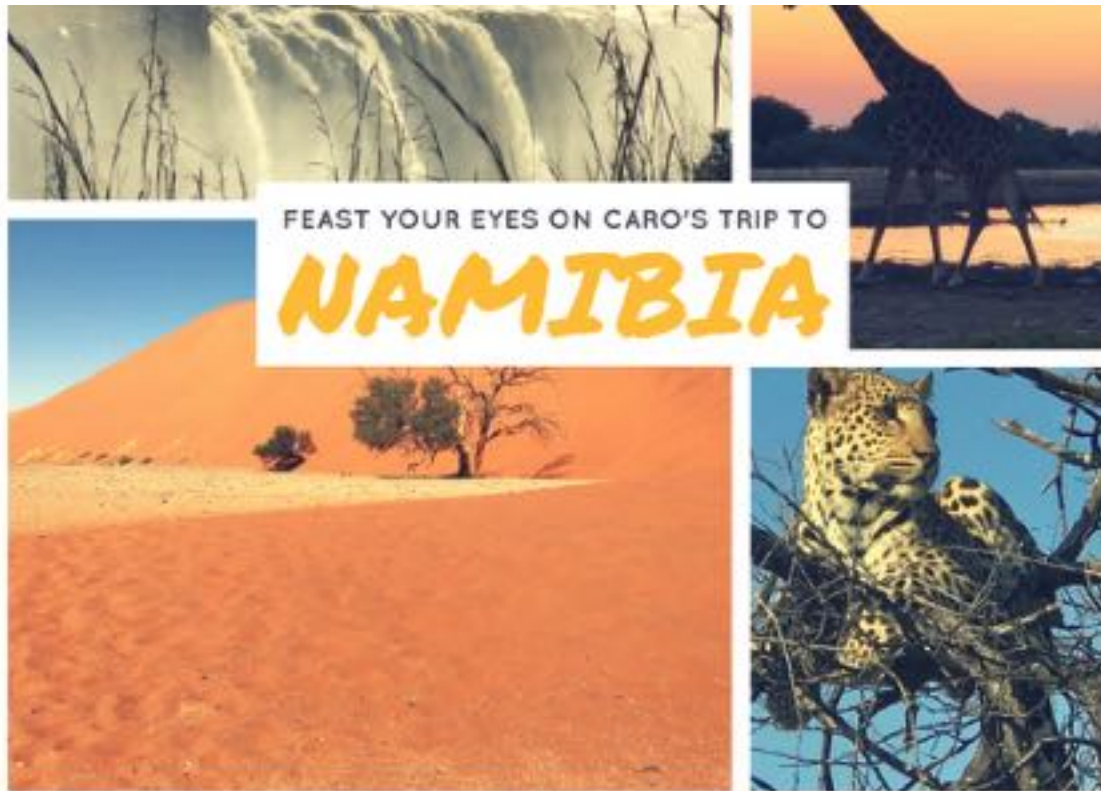


Teaming up with the Galapagos Conservation Trust (GCT)
